Councilmember Harris provided information.

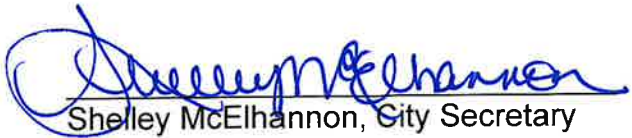
