1. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

1.A Resolution No. 18-2025. A Resolution authorized by Section 418.108(B) of the Texas Government Code consenting to the continuation and renewal of the Mayor's Disaster Declaration regarding the July 4, 2025 Flood Event issued on July 4, 2025 (2nd Extension).

Mike Hayes provided information and responded to questions. The duration of the Disaster Declaration extends indefinitely until deemed by City Manager. Under the City Manager's authority, Subsection F will be suspended with an exception in the Ordinance.

Councilmember Kent McKinney made a motion to approve Resolution No. 18-2025, seconded by Councilmember Brenda Hughes. Motion to approve passed 5-0.

1.B Extension of initial suspension period pursuant to City Council's declaration of a catastrophe pursuant to Section 552.2325, Texas Local Government Code; establishing subsequent seven day suspension period related to open records; directing the City Manager to submit notice of this suspension period to the Texas Attorney General as provided by state law.

Mike Hayes provided information and responded to questions.

Councilmember Hughes made a motion to approve the extension of the Disaster Declaration, seconded by Councilmember Sigerman. Motion to approve passed 5-0.

1.C July 4, 2025 flood event, status of recovery efforts, and City's continuing response.

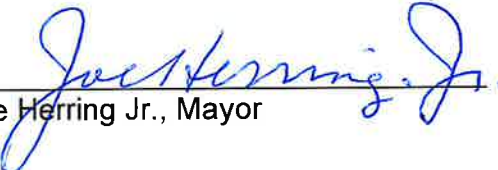

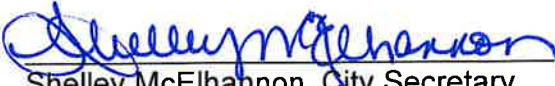
2. **EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Executive Session was not called.
