Dalton Rice provided information.

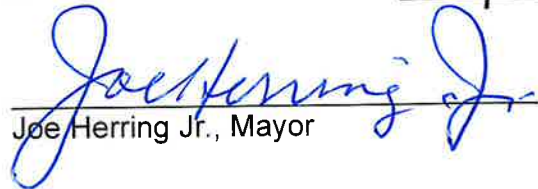
