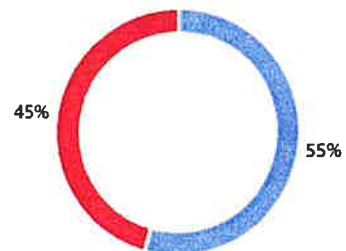

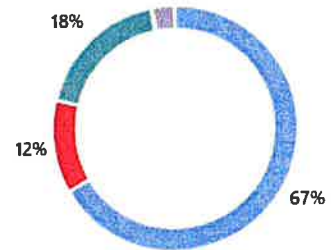
4. If there was a Recovery Community vehicle available, would you volunteer your time to help drive others?

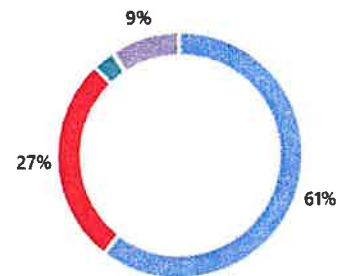
5. Do you have a valid Texas driver's license?

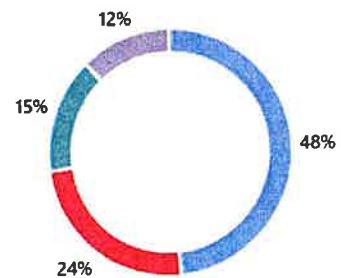
6. Do you have a vehicle?

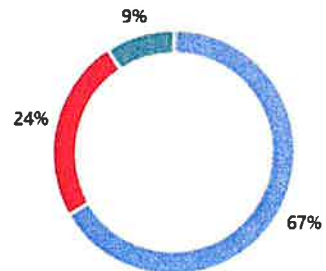

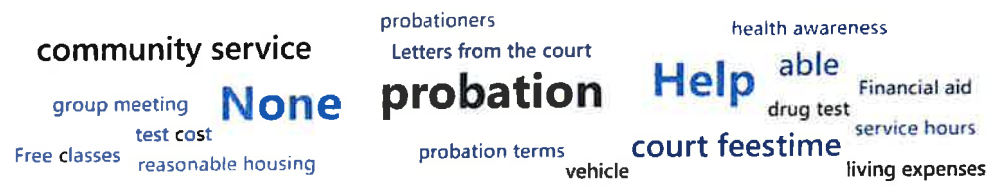
10. What support, if any, would be helpful to your legal situation?
