



EMERGENCY MEETING

Pursuant to Section 551.045, Texas Government Code, the City Council for the City of Kerrville, Texas, will hold an Emergency Meeting due to an urgent public necessity, namely the extreme and widespread flooding that occurred on and after July 4, 2025. This extreme weather event caused severe property damage, injury, and loss of life, which requires the City Council to deliberate or take action on this emergency and urgent public necessity. The City's response continues to require immediate action, which is required because of an imminent threat to public health and safety, including a threat caused by the flood, rain, power failure, and other conditions.

1. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

- 1.A Resolution No. 17-2025. A Resolution authorized by Section 418.108(B) of the Texas Government Code continuing and renewing the Mayor's Disaster Declaration regarding the July 4, 2025 Flood Event issued on July 4, 2025.
- 1.B Declaring a catastrophe pursuant to Section 552.2325, Texas Local Government Code, and establishing an initial seven day suspension period related to open records; directing the City Manager to submit the suspension and any subsequent extension to the suspensions to the Texas Attorney General as provided by state law.
- 1.C July 4, 2025 flood event, status of recovery efforts, and City's continuing response.

2. EXECUTIVE SESSION: *City Council may, as permitted by law, adjourn into executive session at any time to discuss any matter listed above if items meet the qualifications in Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.*

3. ACTION ON ITEMS DISCUSSED IN EXECUTIVE SESSION, IF ANY.
